ASSEMBLAGE ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. 89-3-TS

An ordinance regulating the assemblage of people within the Town of Lafayette, Chippewa County, Wisconsin, and adopted on June 6, 1977, is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

The Town Board of the Town of Lafayette does ordain as follows:

I. INTENT AND SEVERABILITY.

- A. It is the purpose of the Town Board of the Town of Lafayette to regulate the assemblage of people in numbers in excess of those normally needing the health, sanitary, fire, police, transportation and utility services regularly provided in the Town of Lafayette, in order that the health, safety and welfare of all persons in said Town, residents and visitors alike, may be protected.
- B. It is the intent of this ordinance that all sections and provisions of this ordinance have an independent existence, and, should any section or provision be declared invalid or unconstitutional or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances shall be declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of the provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision(s) or application(s).

II. LICENSE REQUIRED.

- A. No person shall permit, maintain, promote, act as entrepreneur for, undertake, organize, manage, or sell or give tickets to an assembly of people which shall continue, or which is reasonably anticipated to continue, for four (4) or more consecutive hours, whether on public or private property, unless said person has first been issued a license to hold the assembly by the Clerk of the Town of Lafayette. Application for said license shall be made to the Town Clerk at least thirty (30) days in advance of the planned assembly or function.
- B. DEFINITIONS. As used in this Ordinance:
 - 1. "Persons" shall mean any natural human being, partnership. corporation, firm, company, association, society, or group;
 - 2. An "Assembly" shall consist of three (3) or more persons gathered together at any location at any single time for any purpose.
- C. A separate license shall be required for each day, or part thereof, and for each location upon which the applicant plans on gathering the assembly.
