

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND REGULATING
THE BRICK MEMORIAL LANDING
IN THE TOWN OF LAFAYETTE

ORDINANCE NO. 85701

July 1985

The Town Board of the Town of Lafayette, Chippewa County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION I - STATEMENT OF INTENT

The town boat landing, hereby created is owned and maintained by the Town of Lafayette, for the benefit of the general public and the Town, in the proper exercise of its police powers, has the right and duty to manage and control Town owned property for the good order of the Town and for the health, safety, welfare and convenience of the public.

SECTION II - CREATION OF THE BRICK MEMORIAL LANDING

The Town Board of the Town of Lafayette, hereby creates the Brick Memorial Landing, located in the Town of Lafayette on the land described as follows:

Lot D of Sun Rise Point Addition to the Town of Lafayette, except the parcel sold to the State of Wisconsin as a part of Highway "29" which is now County Highway X.

for the purpose of embarkation and disembarkation of boats on Lake Wissota.

SECTION III. REGULATIONS FOR USE OF BRICK MEMORIAL LANDING.

A. Capacity and Right to Entry. The capacity of the parking lot for the Brick Memorial Landing shall be set at Fifty (50) cars or trucks, with boat trailers and entry shall be on a first come-first serve basis.

B. Limited Parking. There shall be no overnight parking in the Brick Memorial Landing parking lot.

C. Hours. The Town Board of the Town of Lafayette shall have the authority to regulate the daily hours during which the Brick Memorial Landing shall be open to the public.

D. Season. The Town Board of the Town of Lafayette shall have the authority to regulate the dates on which the Brick Memorial Landing shall be open to the public, and shall have the right to open and close said landing as the weather conditions and public needs dictate.

E. Prohibited Conduct. In addition to such other activities and conduct which the Town Board may, at its discretion, from time to time, deem necessary to limit or prohibit for the protection of the health and safety of the general public, or to main-
